PUBLIC COMMENTS – 6:21

Mayor Mouanoutoua requested a moment of silence in honor of former Fresno County Supervisor Stan Oken and U.S. troops.

Steven Trevino, resident, spoke about the importance of preserving Clovis history and suggested local libraries include the Clovis Children's book.

Brian Wilson, resident, noted that the Clovis Library has five copies of the book available in its inventory.

Eddie Stark, resident, raised concerns about limited parking at the senior center and suggested relocating city buses or the transit center to free up parking spaces and expand facilities for seniors, while also asking about plans for the nation's upcoming 250th anniversary.

Bill Scott, resident, encouraged the city to recognize and commemorate key historical events related to the 250th anniversary of the United States, including Revolutionary War milestones throughout the year.
