5:15 ITEM 3. DISCUSSION AND VOTE: NAMING THE E-BIKE SAFETY BOOTH FOR CLOVIS TRAIL FEST.

Recreation Coordinator MaiKou Yang, and Police Officer Zach Pigott, gave a brief update on Trail Fest, outlining the purpose of the event and what the Youth Commission booth will offer. They explained the focus of the booth, the activities planned and provided guidance to the commissioners on how to approach selecting a name for their own booth, encouraging something clear, inviting, and reflective of the booth's purpose.

Commissioner Yang shared fact sheets outlining the dos and don'ts of electronic bike safety, including the Ride Safe, Ride Smart campaign materials. The information was intended to help spark ideas and guide the commissioners as they brainstormed booth names.

Several names were suggested, including The Helmet Hangout; Helmet Handout; Ride Smart, Ride Safe; Bicycle Turnup and Helmet Giveaway; Helmet Giveaway; and Bike Helmet Giveaway

and Obstacle Course. After discussion, the group reached consensus on the name Bike Helmet Giveaway and Obstacle Course.

5:29 ITEM 4. ONGOING WORK SESSION: E-BIKE SAFETY INITIATIVE.

The commission divided into three groups to work on the initiative. One group worked with Police Service Officer Ty Woods to develop a short e-bike safety film intended for social media and the Police Department website. A second group collaborated with Recreation Coordinator MaiKou Yang on planning details for the event booth. A third group worked with Officer Zach Pigott to develop the educational handout and flyer.

6:45 ITEM 5. PROJECT UPDATE AND NEXT STEPS: E-BIKE SAFETY INITIATIVE.

Commissioners Anderson, Menz, Ndole, Parmer, Sohi, Moore, and Takhar returned to the meeting at 6:45 p.m.

The E-Bike committee reported that they filmed video footage throughout the entirety of the meeting. One group collaborated with Police Officer Zach Pigott to develop a pamphlet and flyer that will be distributed at Trail Fest, which includes safety tips for electric bikes and scooters, and will coordinate with City Clerk Parra to finalize the handout before the next meeting. A second group worked with Recreation Coordinator MaiKou Yang to plan activities for the Trail Fest booth, including a helmet giveaway and a bike obstacle course. Commissioners voted to name the booth "The Bike Helmet Giveaway and Obstacle Course" and notified City Clerk Parra in advance regarding attendance and which commissioners will or will not be present on the day of the event.
