OPENING BUSINESS

5:19 ITEM 1. APPROVE MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER 15, 2025, REGULAR MEETING

Motion by Commissioner McCollum, Seconded by Commissioner Takhar, the Minutes for September 15, 2025, were approved. Motion carried by 17-0-4, with Commissioners Menz, Ndole, Parmer, and Sohi absent.

5:19 ITEM 2. WELCOME BY CLOVIS CITY COUNCIL AND CITY MANAGER

Councilmembers Ashbeck and Basgall, along with Mayor Mouanoutoua, introduced themselves and shared brief remarks about the City of Clovis. Then introductions were made by City Manager Haussler, Assistant City Manager Armendariz, Police Officer Jacobsen, Officer Gilles, and Police Corporal O'Brien. Following this, each Youth Commissioner introduced themselves by stating their name, grade, school, years of service on the Commission, and current involvement. The Commissioners were then given the opportunity to ask questions to the council, which focused on the rotation of the mayor and mayor pro tem, the formation of the Youth Commission, and how the council collaborates with other areas of city government.

5:57 ITEM 3. MEASURE Y OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE REPORT OUT BY EX-OFFICIO MOORE

Measure Y Ex-Officio Moore reported back to the Commission on key takeaways from the first Measure Y Oversight Committee meeting held on September 25, 2025. The update included an overview of the City's 1% sales tax revenue, the budget allocation process, and a summary of expenditures to date.

6:05 ITEM 4. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION REGARDING SUBSTANCE AWARENESS RELATED TO VAPING IN SCHOOLS.

PRELIMINARY - SUBJECT TO APPROVAL

Corporal O'Brien provided an overview of current issues in the City of Clovis related to Tobacco Retail Licenses and existing policies governing the number of tobacco retail stores allowed within the city. He discussed challenges these stores create when selling products to minors and shared several examples of how some businesses conceal these products.

Following Corporal O'Brien's presentation and a discussion among the Commissioners, an Ad Hoc Committee was formed to work with Police Corporal O'Brien and Lead Police Service Officer Negrete on developing an updated Tobacco Retail License policy to be presented to City Council in the spring. Ad Hoc Committee members are Ellie Hammond, Luz Hernandez-Lopez, Chaheti Mathur, Abigail Nevin, Peter Sauer, Evan Allgood, and Ayanna Rana.

6:28 ITEM 5. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION REGARDING MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVES

Police Officer Jacobsen provided an overview and presentation to the Commissioners on potential ways the Youth Commission can give back to the community, with a focus on mental health and community needs. Police Officer Jacobsen suggested several ideas, including organizing a clothing donation drive during the December 1, 2025, Tree Lighting event. The drive would collect clothing for newborns through age 17 to support families in need. All collected items will be donated to Exceptional Parents Unlimited. An Ad Hoc Committee was created, and the appointed Commissioners are Avereet Samra, Maggie McCollum, Grace Yang, Courtlin Pulliam, Micah Gurman, Amaan Gill, and Alian Marriaga.

6:40 ITEM 6. PRESENTATION AND DISCUSSION REGARDING E-BIKE AND SCOOTER SAFETY

Officer Gilles provided an overview and presentation to the Commissioners on electronic bikes and scooters. He explained what is legal and illegal to ride on city streets, emphasized the importance of wearing helmets, and discussed general safety practices for using electronic bikes.

The Commission discussed developing a main project focused on a helmet and safety education campaign and giveaway. The committee also considered creating a short educational video that could be featured on the Youth Commission and CUSD websites, as well as the possibility of organizing a school assembly. Ad Hoc Committee Members are Roshan Takhar, Noah Anderson, Jasmine Parmer, Joelle Moore, Amanat Sohi, Madeleine Menz, and Nicole Ndole.


