PUBLIC COMMENT – 5:16

Commissioners Mathur and Marriaga shared an update on the Leadership Summit they attended on November 15th, where they represented the Youth Commission. They highlighted discussions on e-bike safety and education, outreach ideas, a potential helmet-drive initiative, and ways AI can be used as an everyday tool.

They also noted that the summit provided an opportunity to connect with several leaders and participants, including Anya Dalal, Co-Founder and Chair, California Association of Youth Commissions (CAYC), Asha Weinstein Agrawal, PhD, Mineta Transportation Institute, Representatives from the Office of Assemblymember Diana Papan, and Leslie Ragsdale, Vice Mayor of Hillsborough.

5:22 ITEM 1. APPROVE MINUTES FROM OCTOBER 15, 2025, REGULAR MEETING AND OCTOBER 25, 2025, SPECIAL MEETING TOLLEY TOUR.

Commissioner Mathur moved to approve the minutes from October 15, 2025, Regular Meeting and October 25, 2025, Special Meeting (Tolley Tour). Commissioner Sauer seconded. The motion passed 20-0-1, with Commissioner Sohi absent.

5:23 ITEM 2. GENERAL PLAN COMMITTEE REPORT OUT BY EX-OFFICIO HAMMOND.

GPAC Ex-Officio Hammond briefed the commission on key takeaways from the meeting, including discussions on city growth, tourism, housing, and ways to preserve the Clovis way of life as the community continues to change.

5:27 ITEM 3. UPDATE FROM THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON MENTAL HEALTH INITIATIVES REGARDING CLOTHING DRIVE.

The Mental Health Committee provided an overview of their upcoming clothing drive, which will kick off on December 1st, along with their planned presentation to the City Council. The Committee encouraged Commissioners to distribute flyers within their neighborhoods, local businesses, and

among friends and family. The Committee also noted that the donation bins will be decorated on Saturday, November 22, 2025, and that a short promotional video will be prepared to encourage community participation.

5:38 ITEM 4. UPDATE FROM THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON SUBSTANCE ABUSE – TOBACCO POLICY.

The Tobacco/Substance Abuse Committee discussed its plans to increase community awareness and to revise the policy related to tobacco businesses. The Commission requested clarification from Corporal O'Brien regarding the process and how the Committee may assist with drafting a policy for presentation to the City Council in early 2026.

5:46 ITEM 5. UPDATE FROM THE AD HOC COMMITTEE ON E-BIKE AND SCOOTER SAFETY.

The E-Bike and Scooter Safety Committee discussed plans to create educational safety videos in partnership with the Buchanan News Network for presentations at local schools. The Committee will focus on safety education for both elementary and high school students, with the goal of having the Clovis Unified School District share and promote the short videos.

5:58 ITEM 6. AD HOC COMMITTEE TEAM BREAKOUT.

The Ad Hoc Committees provided updates to the full Commission. The Mental Health Committee, led by Commissioner Gill, shared concepts for a social media awareness campaign, including an informational video to be filmed at the Christmas Tree Lighting. The E-Bike and Scooter Safety Committee, led by Commissioner Parmer, discussed plans for two educational videos, one for elementary students and one for high school students, to be presented at schools. The Tobacco/Substance Abuse Committee, led by Commissioner Hammond, identified designated "sensitive areas," such as schools, churches, and parks, where tobacco businesses should not be located.
