However, staff cannot guarantee that written comments received after 4:00 p.m. will be provided to City Council during the meeting. All written comments received prior to the end of the meeting will be made part of the record of proceedings.

CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION PROHIBITIONS AND MANDATORY DISCLOSURE –

Pursuant to Government Code section 84308, a Councilmember shall not accept, solicit, or direct a campaign contribution of more than \$500 from any party or their agent, or from any participant or their agent, while a proceeding involving a license, permit, contract, or other entitlement for use is pending before the City or for 12 months after a final decision is rendered in that proceeding. Any Councilmember who has received a campaign contribution of more than \$500 within the preceding 12 months from a party or their agent, or from a participant or their agent, must disclose that fact on the record of the proceeding and shall not make, participate in making, or in any way attempt to use their official position to influence the decision.

Pursuant to Government Code section 84308, subdivision (e), any party to a covered proceeding before the City Council is required to disclose on the record of the proceeding any campaign contribution, including aggregated contributions, of more than \$500 made within the preceding 12 months by the party or their agent to any Councilmember. The disclosure shall be made as required by Government Code Section 84308, subdivision (e)(1) and California Code of Regulations, Title 2, section 18438.8. No party or their agent, and no participant or their agent, shall make a campaign contribution of more than \$500 to any Councilmember during the covered proceeding or for 12 months after a final decision is made in that proceeding. The foregoing statements do not constitute legal advice, and parties and participants are urged to consult with their own legal counsel regarding the applicable requirements of the law.

Proclamation

Declaring Clovis on Tour as The Official Children's Book of the City of Clovis

WHEREAS, In November 2023, under the vision and encouragement of Former Mayor Lynne Ashbeck, the City of Clovis began work on a children's book to highlight the history, landmarks, and values that make Clovis unique, emphasizing themes such as resilience, gratitude, community, and hard work with the intent of preserving our history and exposing young people to the important people and milestones that make our City great; and

WHEREAS, the book Clovis on Tour: Connecting Kids to the Story of their Hometown reflects the values of Clovis, including supporting one another, honoring Veterans and farmers, staying healthy, solving problems, bringing people together, remembering important moments in history, and appreciating the service of police officers and firefighters; and

WHEREAS, the City partnered with the Clovis Unified School District, Clovis Community Foundation, Clovis Rodeo, Clovis Community Medical Center, Clovis Veterans Memorial District, Old Town Clovis Museum, and other community partners who contributed to the creation of this book; and

WHEREAS, this book will be placed in every third-grade classroom and elementary school library within the Clovis Unified School District; and

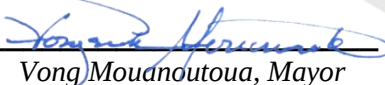

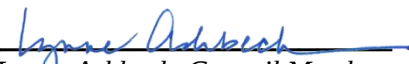

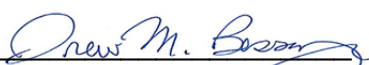
Clovis On Tour - Official City of Clovis Children's Book
